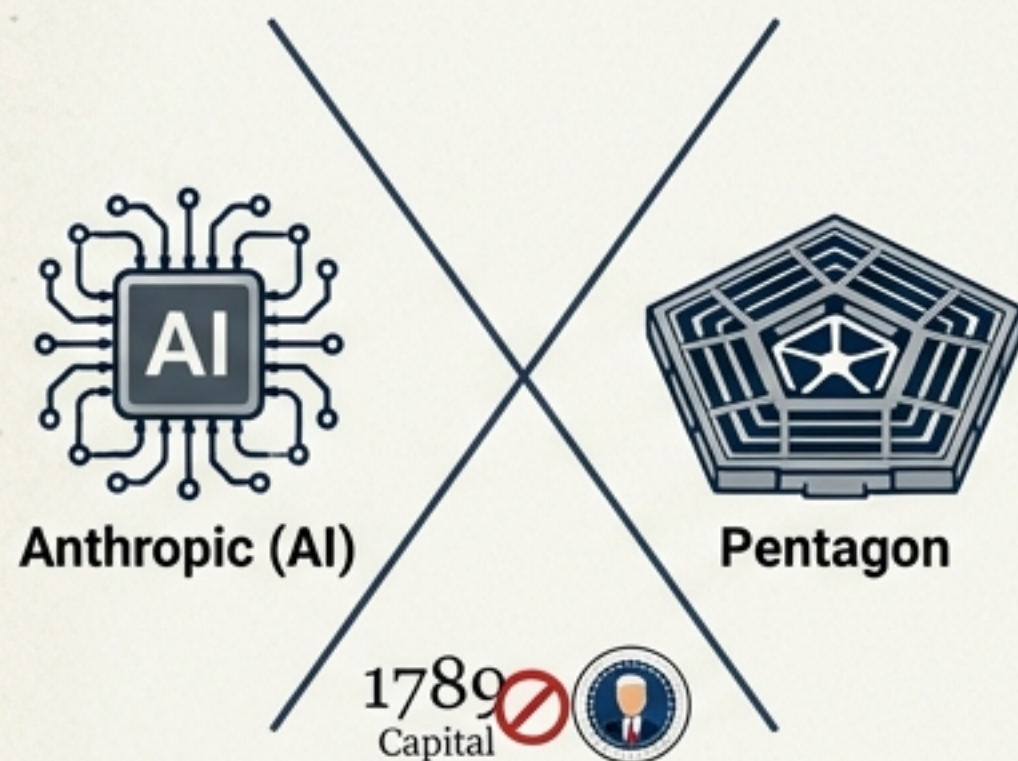

Synthesis of Global Trends

1 THE PEACE IS PURCHASED



Stability in the Middle East is being negotiated through transactional "deals" (The Board of Peace, \$1B Entry Fee) and overwhelming military threat, rather than traditional diplomacy.

2 DIGITAL AMBITION, PHYSICAL LIMITS



The AI revolution is hitting a hard wall of land scarcity, energy deficits, and housing conflicts (Virginia/India). Simultaneously, governments are moving to restrict the "screen" access of the next generation.

3 THE WESTERN FRACTURE



The Trans-Atlantic alliance is drifting. Germany and France are split on nuclear defense; US Climate policy is diverging from the rest of the developed world.
